





Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- 1/4 cup onion, finely chopped
- 2 (15.8 ounce) cans of great northern beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can diced tomatoes with basil, garlic and oregano
- 1 (14 ounce) can low-sodium vegetable or chicken broth
- 4 cups kale, torn into small pieces
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- ½ cup grated Parmesan cheese

Directions:

- 1. In a medium saucepan, heat oil over medium heat and sauté garlic and onion for 3 minutes or until onion is tender.
- 2. Add beans, tomatoes and broth to saucepan. Stir and simmer for 5 minutes. Add kale and cook until tender, for about 2 minutes.
- 3. Mix in lemon juice and Parmesan cheese just before serving. Optional, garnish with finely chopped fresh basil or dried basil.

Notes

Cooked, dried beans may be substituted for canned beans. Using prepared dry beans in place of canned will reduce sodium in this dish. If you can't find diced tomatoes with basil, garlic and oregano, use regular diced tomatoes and add dried versions of these seasonings.



ELIGIBLITY: Contest is open only to school students attending public school, private, or home school located within the Commonwealth of Kentucky enrolled in Kindergarten through 12th grade.

HOW TO ENTER: To enter the Contest,

1. Create an original piggy bank design as described below. Only one entry per youth.

2. Bring entry and Official Entry Form to Amy Branstetter, at the Metcalfe Co. Extension Office by: **November 22, 2024.**

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Entries must meet the following requirements to be eligible for judging:

- A. The bank cannot exceed 12 inches x 12 inches x 12 inches (1 square foot)
- B. Piggy banks must be able to hold coins (i.e. include a slot that has been cut to insert coins).
- C. Piggy banks must be created or decorated by the youth contestant.
- D. Plastic or ceramic piggy banks may be used, but must be personally decorated.
- E. Piggy banks DO NOT have to be in the shape of a pig.
- F. Entrant MAY use or repurpose other containers.
- G. Write a description of your design.
