## <u>PLATE – IT – UP KENTUCKY PROUD</u> RECIPE:



### **BLACKBERRY CUCUMBER SALAD**

# **Ingredients:**

3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
1 teaspoon honey
Kosher salt, to taste
Black pepper, to taste
4 cups spring mix
3 heaping cups blackberries
2 cucumbers, peeled and seeds scraped out, cut into 1-inch pieces on a diagonal
1 cup mint, chopped
1/4 cup chopped pecans

#### Yield:

4-6, 4-ounce servings

### **Directions:**

In a small bowl, **whisk** together oil, vinegar, honey and salt and pepper. **Combine** spring mix, blackberries, cucumbers, mint, and pecans in a large serving bowl. **Toss** with dressing.
